Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the "Act"), dated 12 November 2019, for the following information;

"I'm looking to get data on the total number of income drawdown policies in existence.

I know that you publish data (Retirement Income Data) that outlines the number of new plans established, but I am looking to get a breakdown of the total number of drawdown plans that are in operation.

If you have the data, any further breakdown detailing age, gender, advised or non-advised, year of being established would be very helpful."

Your request has now been considered and our response is set out below.

We can provide information in relation to the income drawdown policies as mentioned in your request, from data that we hold on the stock of pension plans in drawdown. We have included data that we hold on partially crystallised plans as well as those that are fully crystallised. This can be seen in the table below.

DC contract-based pension plans	At 31 March 2019
