# 1 Overview

### Legislative changes this month

### The Handbook

- 1.1 On 21 February 2013 the FSA Board made changes to the Handbook in two instrument which:
  - make a number of technical adjustments to fees, clarify existing practice, remove certain discounts, and bring into line invoicing arrangements for certain fee-payers (FSA 2013/4); and
  - make changes to the Conduct of Business sourcebook (COBS) to clarify rules on new business in with-profits funds (FSA 2013/5).
- 1.2 These instruments are all listed in Annex A and the changes will be listed in Chapter 2 of this Notice.

### Changes outside the Handbook

1.3 For changes outside the Handbook see Chapter 3 of this Notice.

### **Description of changes**

The legislative changes referred to above are listed and briefly described in Chapters 2 and 3 1.4 (where appropriate) of this Notice.

## Handbook changes made by the Board

### Fees manual (FEES)

Fees (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No 6) Instrument 2013(FSA 2013/4)

Following consultation in Chapters 4 and 5 of CP12/28<sup>1</sup>, the Board has made the following changes in the Handbook:

- 2.4 In summary, these amendments:
  - make technical adjustments to fees under listing rules;
  - clarify our existing practice that firms may provide us with estimates of the data on which their fees are based beyond the first year of authorisation, until they are able to report the results of a full year of trading, removing an ambiguity in the current drafting of the rule;
  - remove the 30% discount on fees paid by wholesale depositors and which is also applied to the Money Advice Service (MAS) levy; and
  - bring the invoicing arrangements for Recognised Investment Exchanges (RIEs), Recognised Clearing Houses (RCHs) and Designated Bodies (DPBs) into line with other fee-payers.
- 2.5 This instrument comes into force on 1 April 2013. Feedback to this consultation is set out in Chapter 4 of this Notice.

### **BUSINESS STANDARDS**

### **Conduct of Business sourcebook (COBS)**

Conduct of Business Sourcebook (With-Profits Business) (Amendment) Instrument 2013 (FSA 2013/5)

Following consultation in Chapter 7 of CP12/27<sup>2</sup>, the Board has made the following 2.6 changes in the Handbook:

Changes: Changes to COBS 20.2.28AG

- 2.7 In summary, the changes make amendments to the guidance related to rules on new business connected to with-profits funds, so that they fully reflect our policy intention as consulted on in CP11/5<sup>3</sup> and set out in PS12/4.<sup>4</sup>
- 2.8 This instrument comes into force on 6 March 2013. Feedback to this consultation is set out in Chapter 4 of this Notice.

## Changes outside the Handbook

3.1 There are no material changes outside the Handbook.

### Feedback on responses to consultation

- 4.1 This chapter provides feedback on the following consultation:
  - Chapter 7 of CP12/27, Quarterly consultation (No 34), (October 2012); and
  - Chapters 4 and 5 of CP12/28, Regulatory fees and levies: Policy proposals for 2013/14, (October 2012).

### Chapter 7 of CP12/27, Quarterly consultation (No 34)

Conduct of Business Sourcebook (With-Profits Business) (Amendment) Instrument 2013 (FSA 2013/5)

### Conduct of Business sourcebook (COBS)

- 4.2 In Chapter 7 of CP12/27, we consulted on an amendment to guidance changes contained in a previous instrument<sup>5</sup>, following feedback from firms after the publication of PS12/4<sup>6</sup>. The previous instrument, included tighter guidance on how new business can be written in a with-profits fund.
- 4.3 Firms pointed out that the wording of the rules and guidance could be interpreted as meaning that new business must always add positive value to the with-profits fund, such as that the fund should receive a commercial return for the use of the inherited estate to establish the new business. Therefore, they believed firms who took a cost neutral position (that the estate neither gained nor lost from the new business) would be unable to continue this approach following the changes to COBS 20.2.28R and COBS 20.2.28AG(1).

Conduct of Business Sourcebook (With-Profits Business) Instrument 2012 (FSA 2012/10).

PS12/4, Protecting with-profits policyholders: Feedback on CP11/5 and final rules, (March 2012).

- 4.4 The guidance was not intended to suggest that new business should always add value by creating benefit for the fund. Our intention was that the new business should be self supporting and must be expected to create sufficient value to compensate for the cost of writing that business and ensure the new business is not an unfair drain on the inherited estate. Therefore, we proposed to clarify that a cost neutral position is consistent with this by adding additional wording to COBS 21.2.28AG(1).
- 4.5 We asked:
  - Q7.1: Do you agree with the proposal to clarify the wording in COBS 20.2.28AG(1)?
- 4.6 The Association of Financial Mutuals (AFM), on behalf of its members, responded to the consultation to support the proposed changes. The AFM made two points. First, that the change is a clarification to existing guidance, the overall effect of which is to make it clear that a cost-neutral approach is acceptable. This latest clarification should be read in the context of the guidance introduced in PS12/4. We acknowledge this is the case. Second, the AFM asked what happens when a policyholder does not have an expectation of a distribution from the fund. In that circumstance the firm should look at all the relevant factors. Neither of these comments has necessitated any changes to the proposed wording.

### Cost benefit analysis and compatibility statement

Given that the proposed changes reflect the policy intention on which we originally 4.7 consulted, we said in Chapter 7 of CP12/27 that this should not cause significant costs to firms. The compatibility statement for the proposal remains unchanged from that published in Chapter 7 of CP12/27. No comments were made by respondents on this.

### Equality and diversity issues

- We continue to believe that these changes do not give rise to discrimination and are of low 4.8 relevance to the equality agenda. No comments were made on this by respondents.
- 4.9 The changes made by this instrument are listed in paragraphs 2.6 to 2.8 of this Notice.

### Chapters 4 and 5 of CP12/28, Regulatory fees and levies: Policy proposals for 2013/14

Fees (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No 6) Instrument (FSA 2013/4)

### Fees manual (FEES)

### Background

- 4.10 In CP12/28, we consulted on four sets of proposals, all due to come into force from 1 April 2013:
  - amendments and clarifications to fees charged under the listing rules, affecting issuers under the E fee-block;
  - business projections by newly authorised firms, affecting applicants for authorisation and recently authorised firms;
  - removal of fees discount for wholesale banks, affecting firms in fee-block A.1 (deposit acceptors); and
  - amendments to the on-account payment rule, affecting Recognised Investment Exchanges, Recognised Clearing Houses and Designated Professional Bodies.

### Amendments and clarifications to fees charged under the listing rules

In Chapter 4 of CP12/28, we proposed a number of amendments and clarifications to fees 4.11 charged under the listing rules.

### Amendments to listing rules

- 4.12 We proposed the following amendments to the rules:
- 4.13 Recovering costs of reviewing final terms for securities: FEES 3, Annex 5R, Part 2 (Category 8)
  - We proposed to introduce a fee of £25 to recover the costs of reviewing final terms for securities submitted for either a public offer or for the admission of securities to the Official List or Regulated Markets. This is a new process to ensure that final terms comply with the requirements of the Prospectus Directive Regulations which came into force on 1 July 2012.
- 4.14 Separate fees for eligibility for premium and standard listing: FEES 3 Annex 5 Part 1
  - We proposed to replace the current standard charge of £1,430 for reviewing the eligibility of all new applicants for listings with two categories- a premium listing

eligibility fee of £2,450 and a standard listing eligibility fee of £1,100. This takes better account of the work we undertake. The coverage and complexity of the rules for premium listings are significantly greater than for standard listings, and the amount of work undertaken is proportionately greater, so our charges should reflect this.

- 4.15 We will continue to charge the standard fee when a new application for premium listing simply results from the addition of a new holding company onto a company's existing corporate structure. This is because the work involved and the rules applicable are similar to those involved in assessing eligibility for admission to standard listing. However, if the addition of a new holding company is accompanied by a transaction, the full premium eligibility fee would be appropriate.
- We also proposed to extend the standard listing eligibility fee to all standard listings including 4.16 depositary receipts and new issuers of debt securities as well as shares. These are not currently charged and so the work we undertake is subsidised by the other firms in the fee-block.

Vetting fees for convertible securities and asset backed securities: FEES 3, Annex 5, Part 2

We proposed to increase our vetting fee for the review and approval of prospectuses for 4.17 convertible securities and asset backed securities, to bring it into line with the fee charged for the review and approval of prospectuses for equity securities. At present, vetting a prospectus for convertible securities or asset backed securities falls under Category 4 of Annex 5, Part 2 as a 'non-equity prospectus or base prospectus', with a fee of £2,750. We proposed instead to identify it as a separate task and put it into Category 1, so that it attracts the same charge as vetting an equity prospectus – currently £6,270. Convertible securities are linked to underlying equity securities and so the review of the prospectus is similar to the review of an equity prospectus since we need to ensure that there is sufficient information on the underlying shares and on the issuer. An asset backed security is a complex debt security that takes longer to review than a standard debt security.

Rectifying anomalies in some references to listing charges: FEES 3.2.7(q) and (v); FEES 3 Annex 5 Part 1 Category 2

We proposed to rectify a small number of minor inconsistencies we had noticed in the 4.18 drafting of some rules, as explained in detail in paragraph 4.7 of CP12/28.

Policy clarifications affecting multiple issuers or transactions: FEES 3.2.1R, FEES 3.2.7R

We clarified the circumstances in which we do not impose additional charges when 4.19 applications list several issuers on a single document. It had been drawn to our attention that our general rule in FEES 3.2.7R on the obligation to pay fees could be interpreted as requiring us to charge each issuer regardless of the amount of work concerned. The areas of concern were:

### Vetting fees charged in relation to multiple issuers included on one vetting document

- 4.20 We normally charge only one vetting fee for each document we vet, no matter how many issuers are covered by it. In these cases, the issuers named may be separate legal entities but they are not unrelated. In practice, they are part of the same group of companies or subsidiaries of the firms submitting the documents. While there is some additional disclosure to check for each issuer, we only assess the risk, allocate, approve and publish the document once. Similarly, we do not check securities note disclosure or release separate comments for each issuer. Consequently, the work we carry out on any individual document is not significantly affected by the number of issuers named in it.
- 4.21 This does not affect mineral expert reports which, as FEES 3.2.7(x)(2) makes clear, are charged in addition to any other vetting fees.

### Debt programmes with multiple issuers on one application

4.22 When we process debt programmes where there are multiple issuers (ordinarily subsidiaries of the listed parent entity), the number of issuers does not affect the amount of work we carry out and so our practice has been to charge a single admission fee on the basis that the application is in relation to the programme itself and not the issuers.

### Related vetting documents under one transaction where super/significant fee triggered

- FEES 3.2.7R(q) and FEES 3.2.7R(v) set enhanced vetting fees for issuers that require 4.23 documents to be vetted for certain types of transaction, or which are involved in reverse or hostile takeovers or other significant restructurings. They are charged a super transaction fee of £50,000 where market capitalisation is over £1.5 billion and they are new applicants for premium listing or involved in a takeover or restructuring; or where market capitalisation is over £5 billion and they are involved in class 1 transactions or transactions requiring vetting of equity prospectuses or prospectuses relating to depositary receipts. They are charged a significant transaction fee of £20,000 where they are involved in similar circumstances but market capitalisation is over £500 million.
- 4.24 Our practice is to apply only one super or significant fee to a single transaction and then charge any subsequent documents relating to the same transaction at the standard rate set out in FEES 3 Annex 5. For example, an issuer with a market capitalisation in excess of £5 billion, carrying out a class 1 transaction with an issue of consideration shares in relation to the same transaction, would produce a class 1 circular and a separate prospectus. We would charge a super transaction fee of £50,000 for the first document received by the UKLA and £6,270 for the second.

- 4.25 We asked:
  - 07: Do you agree with the amendments and clarifications we are proposing for fees under the listing rules, as set out in Chapter 4 of this CP?
- 4.26 We received only one comment on our proposals under the listing rules. This was from a trade body, supporting the higher fee for premium listing on the ground that: 'Premium listing, and the quality assurance that this implies, is important to our members and it would be right to impose a higher fee where this represents the cost of the additional diligence that FSA performs.'
- 4.27 Since the only response we received was positive, we have proceeded with our proposals unchanged.

### Business projections by newly authorised firms: FEES 4.2.7BR

- 4.28 In Chapter 5 of CP12/28, we proposed some amendments to FEES 4.2.7BR to make it clear that newly authorised firms may annualise the data from which fees relating to the relevant regulated activities are calculated if they have not been able to complete a full data period in relation to their third or subsequent FSA financial year. The rule as currently drafted allows us to accept estimated data for the second year after a firm has been authorised but does not specify what they should do after this. Experience has shown that this does not cover all circumstances and so in practice we do accept annualised data for the third year. Table 5.1 summarised a case which illustrated the problem.
- 4.29 Although we did not anticipate circumstances in which projections would be appropriate beyond four years, we drafted the rule to leave the period open, to avoid being unnecessarily prescriptive.
- 4.30 We asked:
  - Do you agree with our proposed amendment to FEES 4.2.7BR, 08: which will allow newly authorised firms to use projected tariff data until they have been trading for a full year during the relevant reporting period?
- 4.31 We received five responses, all supporting our proposal, though a trade body added that there should be an expectation that estimations will only be accepted where no other information is available.
- 4.32 We endorse the trade body's comment, which reflects our own practice and does not affect the drafting of the instrument, and we are proceeding with the proposal.

4.33 Although not picked up through consultation, we noticed a drafting error when we reviewed the instrument. In FEES 4.2.7B(5)(d)(ii), the reference to 'either the 31 December before the start of the FSA financial year or, if earlier, the day preceding the start date of the firm's financial year' should have been in the first paragraph not the second. The final instrument corrects the error, as set out below:

'in respect of firms satisfying condition (5)(c)(i), the tariff is calculated by reference to the period beginning on the date it acquired the relevant permission relating to the tariff, and ending on either the 31 December before the start of the FSA financial year or, if earlier, the day preceding the start date of the firm's financial year; and

in respect of firms satisfying condition (5)(c)(ii), the tariff is calculated by reference to the period beginning on the date on which it acquired the relevant permission, and ending on either the 31 December before the start of the FSA financial year or, if earlier, the start date of the firm's financial year'.

Removal of fees discount for wholesale banks: FEES 4, Annex 2R, Part 1; FEES 7, Annex 1R

- 4.34 In Chapter 5 of CP12/28, we proposed to remove from 2013/14 the discount of 30% applied to the fees of deposit acceptors in fee-block A.1 whose regulatory activity permissions are limited to accepting deposits from wholesale depositors ('wholesale banks'). Wholesale depositors include credit institutions, large companies (ie not qualifying as small companies under the Companies Acts), large mutual associations, central/local government bodies and companies in the same group as the person with whom the deposit is made. The discount was introduced from 2003/04 on the basis that these firms required reduced supervisory attention but, following a review, we have decided this is no longer the case. In 2012/13 the discount was applied to 18 firms out of the 330 that pay variable periodic fees in fee-block A.1.
- 4.35 We also proposed removing the 30% discount for wholesale banks that is applied to Money Advice Service (MAS) levies. That is because the levy we collect for MAS mirrors our own fees structure and so the discount was carried across automatically.<sup>7</sup>
- **4.36** We asked:
  - **Q9:** Do you agree with our proposal to remove the 30% fees discount for wholesale banks?
  - Q10: Do you have any comments on the proposal to remove the 30% discount for wholesale banks in relation to Money Advice Service levies?

- 4.37 We received seven responses, all commenting on both proposals. None objected to removing the discount on FSA fees, one trade body calling it 'self-evidently the fairest arrangement.'
- 4.38 One respondent, a trade body, argued that the MAS discount should stand. Since MAS operates 'to assist retail customers, which, by definition, are not customers of wholesale banks,' its members 'do not consider it equitable that they contribute to a service which is specifically designed to exclude their wholesale customers.'
- 4.39 We are proceeding with our proposals unchanged. We do not agree with the one argument put forward in favour of retaining the discount for MAS. While wholesale banks do not participate directly in the retail market, they do influence it and benefit from it by producing the products which retail clients buy. It is therefore reasonable that they should make a full contribution towards the costs of MAS.
- 4.40 It should be noted that, since CP12/28, we have consulted on a new cost allocation method for MAS<sup>8</sup>, which will break the automatic link between the MAS levy and our fee structure. Consultation closed on 22 February and we will provide feedback in March.

### Amendments to on-account payment rule: FEES 4.3.6R

- 4.41 In Chapter 5 of CP12/28, we proposed that, when the annual periodic fees for Recognised Investment Exchanges (RIEs), Recognised Clearing Houses (RCHs) and Designated Professional Bodies (DPBs), exceed £50,000, they should pay in two instalments on the same basis as other firms whose fees exceed £50,000. These pay a first instalment on 30 April representing 50% of the previous year's fee and the balance in a second instalment on 1 September. FEES 4.3.6R, which prescribes the 'on-account' rule, does not mention RIEs, RCHs or DPBs, and so we have to consult separately each year about their payments on account. To avoid this unnecessary process, we are bringing these bodies into the on-account rule.
- 4.42 We asked:
  - Q11: Do you have any comments on our proposed amendment to the FEES 4.3.6R on account rule to incorporate RIEs, RCHs and DPBs?
- 4.43 We received no comments and so we are proceeding as proposed.

### Cost benefit analysis and compatibility statement

Section 155(9) of FSMA exempts us from having to carry out a cost benefit analysis on our 4.44 policy proposals for fees. Since we have made no material changes to the proposals on which consulted, the compatibility statement we published in CP12/28 is unchanged.

CP13/2, Regulatory fees and levies: The Money Advice Service cost allocation method for 2013/14, (January 2013).

### **Equality and diversity issues**

- We continue to believe that these changes do not give rise to discrimination and are of 4.45 low relevance to the equality and diversity agenda. No comments were made on this by any respondents.
- The changes made by this instrument are listed in paragraphs 2.3 to 2.5 of this Notice. 4.46
